MCC Course



Course description

- The MCC certificate is a requirement to start a Type Rating course for aircraft with multiple crew.
- Addition to the ability to fly a plane, a very important skill becomes the capacity to cooperate with the available resources, both practical and human.

Prerequisites

- ATPL theoretical exam completed
- Multi Engine Instrument Rating (A)
- Have at least 70 hours of flight experience as PIC on aeroplanes
- English ICAO level 4 or above, fluency in English

Course structure and duration

Ground training | 25 hours | 4 days

During the course lecture, trainees will be introduced to...

- Crew Resource Management (CRM) topics
- Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)
- Aircraft accident analysis and cooperation between crew members and flight psychology.
- Communication, leadership and team working, Problem solving and decision making
- Practical full flight simulator training (1 FFS session = 4 hours)

FFS training 5 sessions | 20 hours | 5 days

Our experience instructor will conduct such training, guiding students through a typical airline operation, using multi-crew environment scenarios. Sometimes abnormal situations will be inserted, or emergency, and the instructor will guide the crew step by step towards the resolution of the problem.
